# **Principal's Report**

- Principal Wallis announced the teachers will start back on Friday and school will be ready Monday morning

- Meet and greet with families will be Thursday, July 29<sup>th</sup> and first day of school on Monday, August
- Teachers have called every child on their roster this week to get a better idea of our enrollment so there will be no surprises
  - Some families have moved
  - Currently sitting at 727
  - Will continue to get applications (typically 10 within first week)
- Sports program will be starting up in MS which will hopefully boost enrollment
- CCA's focus this year is, "We Can, We Will, #bettertogether"
- Dan Moorer, the new Assistant Principal, has a marketing background and is helping with a fresh look to the school

#### III. Financials

## **Monthly Financial Review**

- Financials with Christine Locrotondo
  - Fund balance is a deficit
  - o Chair Danny Dukes questioned when does the church term lease end?
    - There is no anticipation of them leaving anytime soon
  - o Chair Danny Dukes questioned the status of the Georgia Governor's Retention Bonus
    - The money has not been received from the government, but it is expected to hit before the end of the Fiscal Year
  - Christine offered the chance for additional questions at the end of the reading of the financials.
    - Chair Danny Dukes asked how sure are we that the projections are accurate?
      - Christine Locotondo responded that we are fairly comfortable that the projections are accurate to date.
    - Chair Danny Dukes questioned approving the financials as the board stated it believes the financials to be grossly understated.
    - Chair Danny Dukes wants to postpone financials
    - Reagan Hage stated that the ESP would make sure the June financials reflect accurately

### FY22 Budget Review

- Reagan Hage drew attention to the proposal from CEO Jonathan Hage to reduce CSUSA's compensation for fiscal year to help CCA flourish
- Target enrollment is 735
- Georgia calculates FTE (Full Time Equivalent) on 3 period rolling average
- Reagan informed the board of the changes to the staffing matrix
  - o Chair Danny Dukes questioned what is the merit increase?
    - 2% for all staff
- Taxes and benefits
- Professional services
  - Outside staff development will be grant funded
  - \$1,700 will be out of operating
  - Professional fees are a grant allocation
- Vendor services

- Medical supplies funded by American Rescue Plan
- Instructional services
  - Textbooks covered by American Rescue Plan
  - o Instructional license partially grants funded
- Other services
- Fixed expenses
  - Increases across the network
  - We shop our insurance
  - \$24,000 to be paid in insurance based upon 35% increase
    - Property and liability insurance have increased
  - Dr. Bob Durham asked, "Can we ask the state to give us why the coverages for commercial have increased under consideration those claims should have gone down significantly? I think it is appropriate the insurance industry tell us why."
- Capital expenditures
  - o Computer hardware grant funded
  - o FF&E purchase cafeteria tables, enrollment growth, and lamination
  - Net change in \$0 as per board request
